- 4. The maximum number of passengers in the Vehicle must not exceed the number of seat belts in the Vehicle and all passengers must wear seat belts at all times while traveling.
- 5. While driving or allowing the Vehicle to be used on a College Visit, the Owner releases, relieves, discharges and holds harmless the RHSP, its directors, officers, employees, volunteers and agents from any and all liability or claim of liability, whether for personal injury, property damage or otherwise, arising out of or in connection with the Owner or the Vehicle participating in a College Visit.
